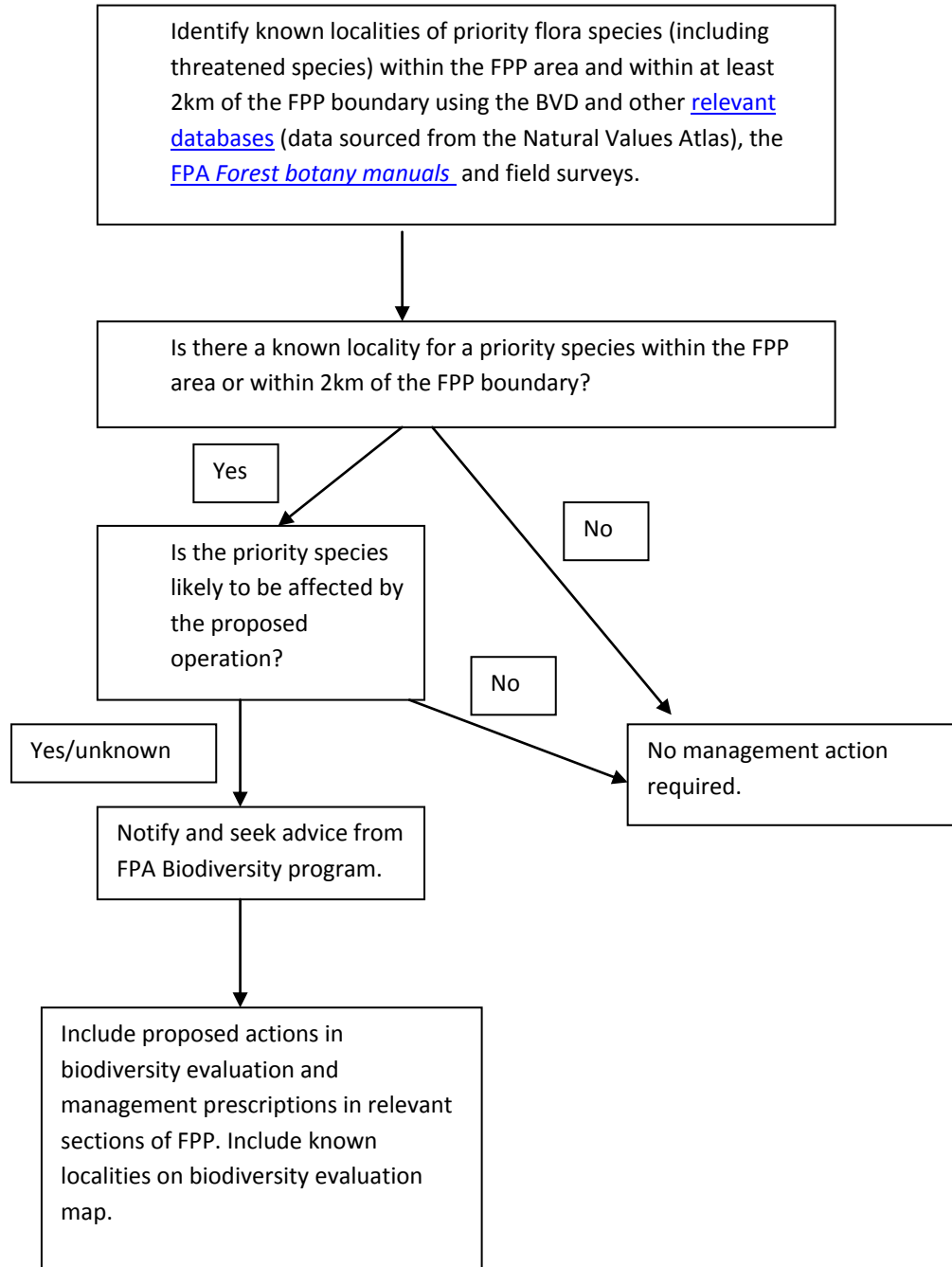

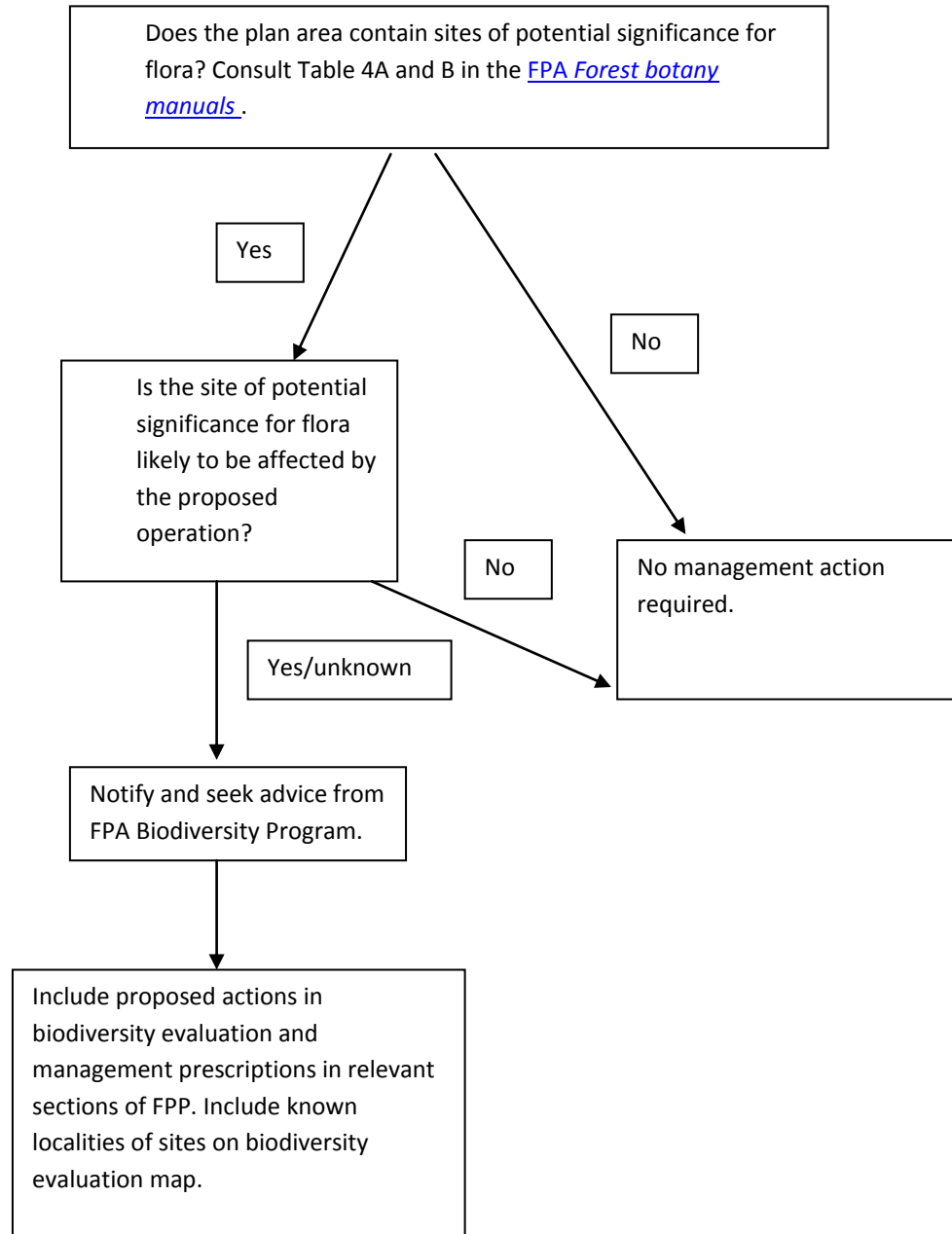
Step 1 – vegetation communities



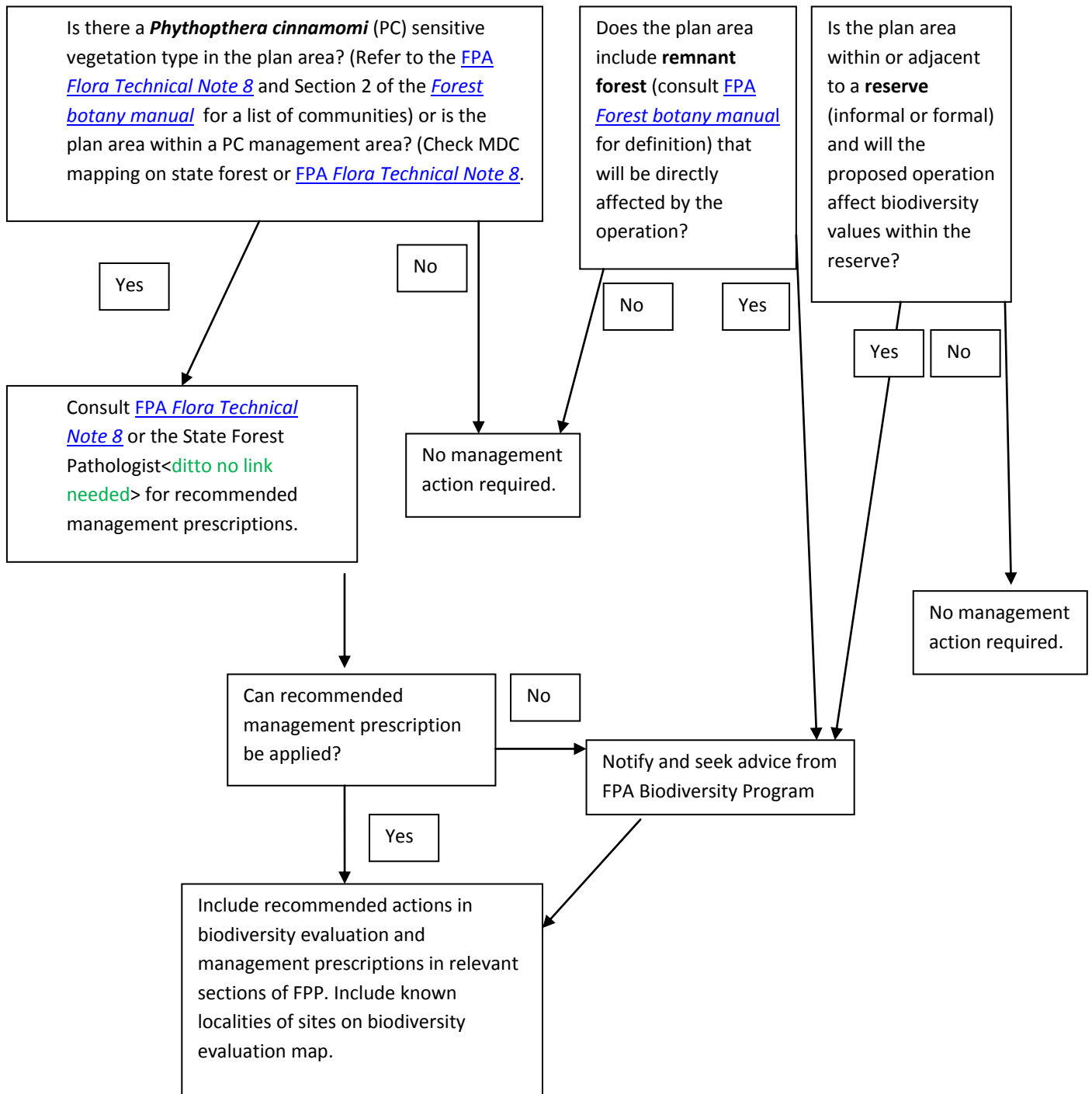
Step 2 – Priority flora species (including threatened species)



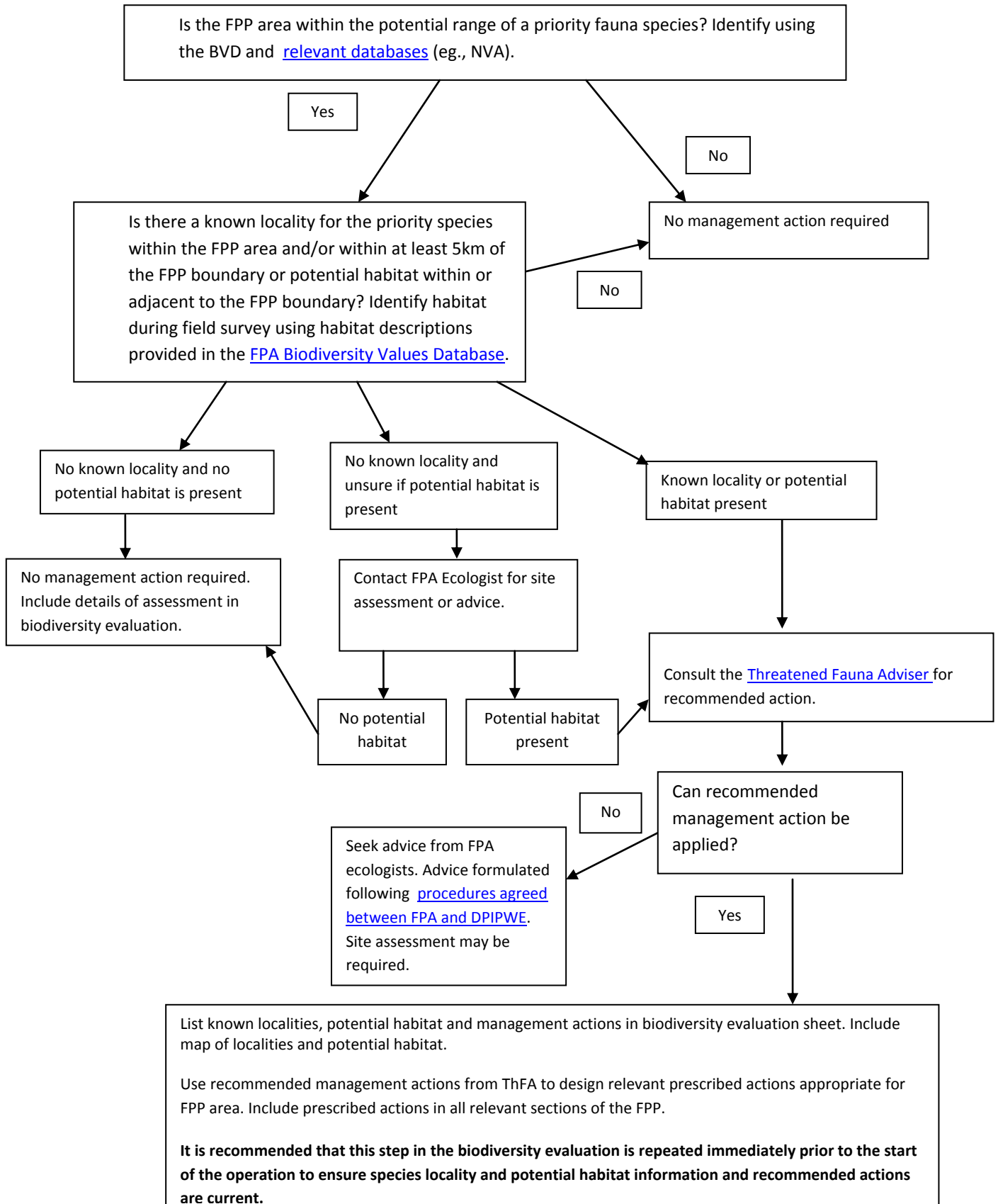
Step 3 – Sites of potential significance for flora



Step 4 – Other flora issues (*Phytophthora cinnamomi*, remnants, reserves)

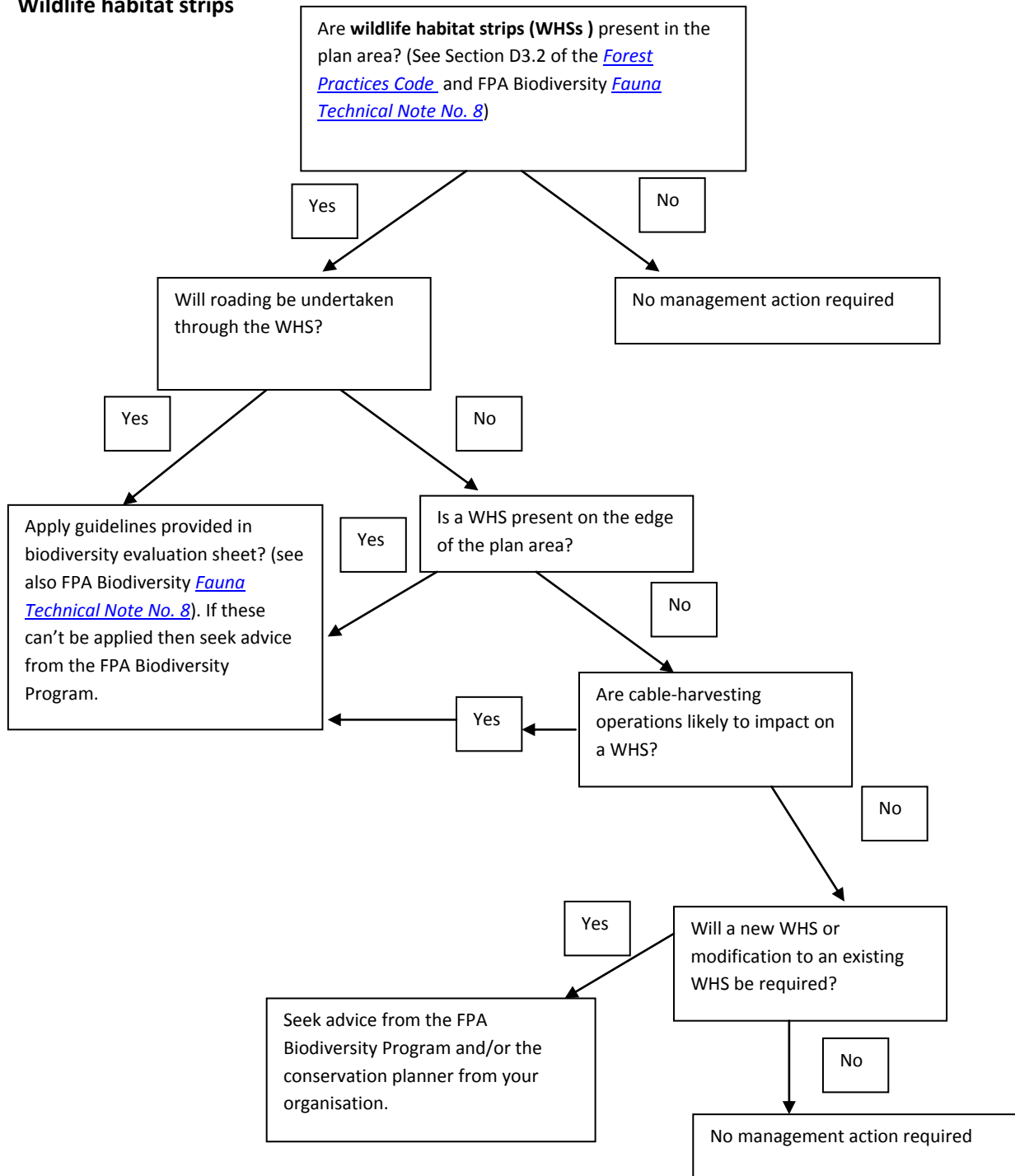


Step 5 - Priority fauna species (including threatened species)

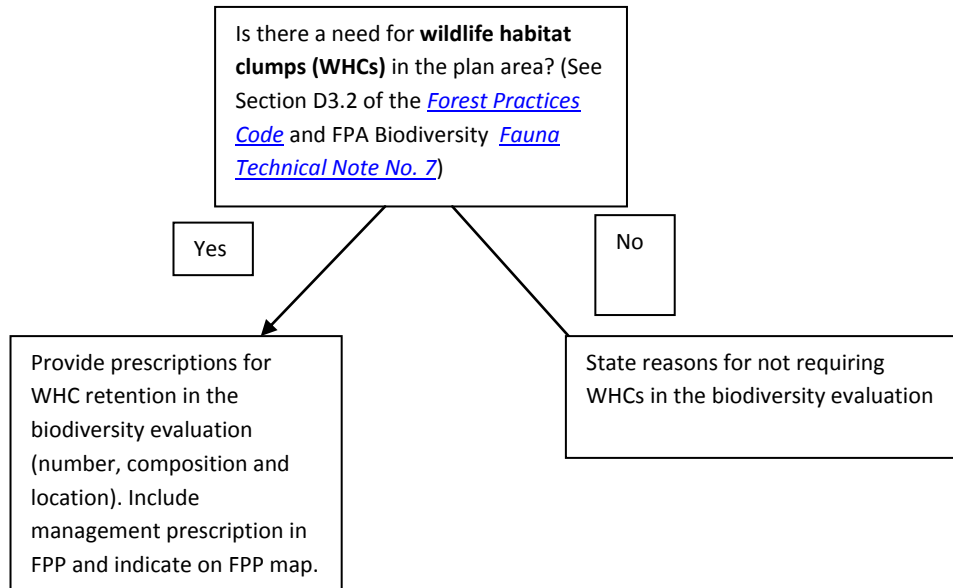


Step 6 – Mature forest
